Former TTC Vice Chairman endorses Conservative Public Transit Plan

Rob Davis Vice-Chairman TTC (1997 to 2000) has endorsed local candidate, Jurij Klufas:

“The conservative plan to offer tax credits for transit users will be a big boost to the TTC and the residents of Toronto. There is no doubt in my mind it will help increase ridership which will in turn increase much needed revenue and reduce green house gas emissions.”
